Caledonia: A new champion identified in Caledonia. This Town appears to more interested in strategic planning and hosting a Charrette.

Macon: Community is open to place building initiative. High school entrepreneurship has been established a Noxubee County High School. The leadership of Noxubee County will utilize, with assistance from EMCC, the Renaissance Plan as its ERDS model. Continuing discussions for implementation are ongoing. The Alliance has employed a new director. A portable welding lab and a new skills classroom were located at the Macon Civic Center.

DeKalb: EMCC and MainStreet Mississippi conducted a Charrette in DeKalb on May 11, 12, 13 2010. Eighty local citizens of Kemper County participated in the Charrette activities. The Charrette encompassed Scooba and surrounding communities. DeKalb is planning a 4th of July celebration, a DeKalb Day and a flea market. A student, who graduated from an EMCC Entrepreneurship Class, is renovating a downtown structure for a business in DeKalb. A new 25-bed hospital is under construction in DeKalb.

Scooba:

A new champion indentified in Scooba. Citizens in Scooba are planning a railroad festival and a Juneteenth Celebration for the community. The Kemper/DeKalb Charrette held on May 11-13, 2010 included recommendations encompassing events for Scooba and the East Mississippi Community College main campus.

EMCC:

The College has implemented a MyBiz.am/SEP short-term workforce training entrepreneurship curriculum. A second class has graduated in May 3 2010. The college has continued to assist the consultants who are working with the Noxubee County School Board and the Noxubee County Renaissance as well as the Noxubee County Alliance. The college is participating in dual enrollment initiatives with three school systems for fall 2010. The college has established a training classroom and portable welding center in Macon. The College has established an M3 and Basic Manufacturing Skills center at its Scooba Campus. EMCC is developing a constructions skills training program with a classroom also being constructed on the Scooba campus.
